With the much heralded Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order RR(FS)O due for implementation in October 2006 we take a look at the impact of the changing Regulatory framework and local authority Fire Brigades' potential enforcement policies for property managers, managing agents, facilities managers and asset managers.

Much has been written about the end of the line for fire certification, but this is only one small part of the changing framework. The coordination of fire safety strategies in multi tenanted workplaces, fire safety management responsibilities for fire warning arrangements, and the fire risk assessment process will all have a significant impact on this sector.
